To make sure you receive the safest, most effective treatment, Arnot Health employs two board certified Nephrologists and a nurse practitioner to provide medical care for dialysis patients and those with chronic kidney disease. These professionals are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Registered Nurses provide oversight for all dialysis treatments. Arnot Health Dialysis Services utilizes a combination of Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses and Patient Care Technicians in rendering direct patient care. Registered Nurses are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week for emergency dialysis treatment.

Registered Dietitians are available for nutritional education and counseling as well as Social Workers to provide psychosocial assessment and counseling.

Arnot Health is the largest provider of dialysis services in the region. Our newly designed state-of-the-art dialysis facility in Elmira has 20 stations and was designed to offer a high degree of patient safety and comfort. Individual TV's, and a large waiting area for family and friends are provided to make your dialysis experience as comfortable as possible. The unit is open six days per week.

In addition to two Elmira locations, outpatient hemodialysis services are also offered at our Corning, NY, facility to make receiving dialysis treatment more convenient.

Each of our facilities offers easy access for patients, ample parking, and utilizes the most advanced hemodialysis equipment available.

Dialysis Therapies

When your kidneys fail, you need some form of dialysis treatment to replace the function of your once healthy kidneys and remove waste, salt and extra water from your blood, keep chemical levels in your body safe, and prevent high blood pressure. Arnot Health Dialysis Services offers hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis and kidney transplant as treatment options.

Hemodialysis - Hemodialysis is the most common method used to treat advanced kidney failure. Our safe, efficient high-flux dialysis therapy, offered in our newly renovated dialysis unit, utilizes state of the art dialysis equipment, and is available to patients on an inpatient and outpatient basis, as well as to transient patients.

Home Peritoneal Dialysis - Home Peritoneal Dialysis cleanses your blood and removes fluid inside the body. Two forms are available: continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis (CAPD), performed without a machine, and continuous cycle peritoneal dialysis (CCPD), performed using a small cycler machine.



Both methods provided complete dialysis therapy and afford the convenience of treating your kidney disease in the comfort of your own home.

The Dialysis staff can help you with all your needs for both methods and provide thorough training to make you comfortable with performing at-home dialysis.

Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy - Continuous veno-venous hemodialysis (CVVH) is available in an inpatient setting to meet the needs of acutely ill patients. Low-flow, continuous hemodialysis therapy provides constant treatment over a 24 hour period to simulate the function of a natural kidney.
