

HIV Primary Care Clinic

Directions To The Elmira Office:

From Interstate 86 East or West (old Route 17); take Elmira exit 56 onto Church Street. Continue on Church Street through the city of Elmira. The street becomes one-way, westbound. Signs to the Arnot Ogden Medical Center will be visible. At a traffic light, take a right turn onto Walnut Street. Continue on Walnut Street, one block past the Roe Avenue intersection. Take a left turn onto Ivy Street. The Ivy Medical Arts Building is on your right, parking is in the rear of the building. Suite 108 is on the first floor.

Directions To The Ithaca Office:

From Route 13 North, turn left onto Buffalo Street. Follow Hospital signs to the Cayuga Medical Center. At the light at the hospital entrance, take a right turn. Then, make a left turn towards the Public Health Department. The WIC building is on the left side of the Public Health Department Building.

The staff consists of a medical director, certified family nurse practitioner, case manager with a Master's of Social Work, licensed practical nurse, registered dietitian and support staff.

- Referrals and affiliations with other agencies and organizations that provide HIV/AIDS-related services, support and care
