From Interstate I-86 (Route 17) East or West, take Elmira exit 56 onto Church Street. Continue on Church Street through the city of Elmira, approximately 3 miles. Signs to the Arnot Ogden Medical Center will be visible. At Church Street and Walnut Street Intersection/traffic light, take a right turn onto Walnut Street. Continue on Walnut Street to the Roe Ave. traffic light. Proceed past the intersection and take the second left onto Ivy St. The Ivy II Medical Office Building is the first parking lot on your right.
